Workshops must be paid in advance, by cheque **by the 15th of the** month and postdated for the day of the workshop. We request that you be there by 9:15 at the latest to set up. Instruction begins at 9:30 am sharp. Payment is due when registering for a workshop. Cheques are to be made payable to Dartmouth Visual Arts Society or DVAS - one separate cheque for each workshop. Please date the cheque the day of the workshop requested (as cheques become stale and non-negotiable after six months).
