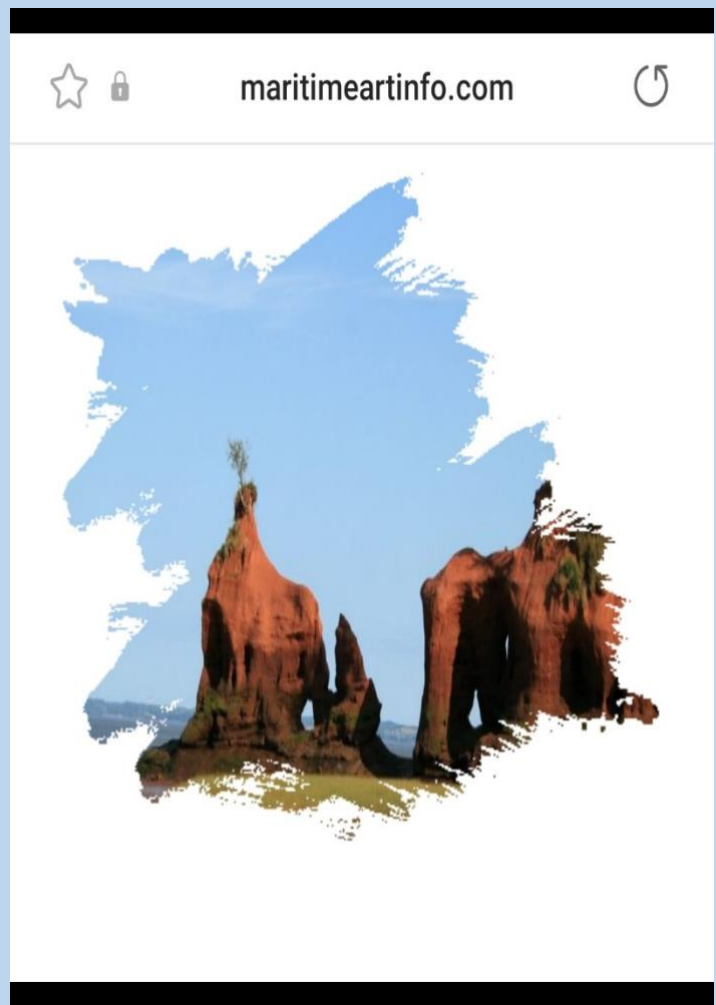
*If you are wondering what happened to the **The Maritime Art List**, you are not alone! Here is all the information you need to know!*
